Air Show the 25th!

The Celebration of Flight is upon us! Beginning on Thursday, the 23rd, our airport will transform into a public event venue intended to showcase the joy of flying, our flying heritage, skillful aerobatic flight, and the value of our general aviation airport to our community and the Valley. There have been several important changes in the schedule and parking arrangements for airport tenants that are detailed in other stories. Spectator parking will all be at the Caldwell Events Center with free shuttle buses starting at 8:30 AM and running all day to carry people directly to the entrance gates. The gates will open at 9 AM and the flying will start about 10 AM. Please help spread the word and encourage as many people as possible to attend to make this our most successful event!



Tickets for Hangar Owners

Just like last year, there is a voucher at the manager's office in Hubler Terminal for each **hangar owner**, which may be exchanged at the gate the day of the air show for tickets for two adults and two children. Pick up vouchers by Noon, Thursday the 23rd.

If you rent, check with the hangar owner for possible sharing opportunities.

The **ticket vouchers are available now!** For best results, call the office to confirm one of us is there before stopping by, (208) 459-9779.

New Air Show Parking Option for Airport Tenants

The parking plan announced in the April newsletter resulted in feedback that many tenants wanted an option to park at the airport. The plan has been changed. The best choice for most people will still be parking at the Caldwell Events Center and riding the continuously running shuttle buses to the entrance gates.

To drive your vehicle to the airport, you will need to pick up a Parking Permit from the airport manager's office by Noon, Thursday, the 23rd. The permit must be displayed on the dash on the driver's side of your vehicle and will allow you access to Aviation Way from Ustick Road. **Aviation Way at Linden will be completely closed to regular traffic.**

The main tenant parking area is just east of the West One house across Aviation Way from the café parking lot. There will still be no parking inside the fence at the hangars during the air show.

If your hangar is on Dishman or Dauntless, you may park there, but expect to have your tickets checked as you enter those streets. (Those without a tenant ticket voucher will need to visit the ticket table at the entrance gates to purchase tickets before parking.)

Thursday Rehearsal

Another item added to the schedule is an air show rehearsal window Thursday the 23rd from 5-7 PM. The airfield will be closed via NOTAM and a waiver will be in effect for the limited aerobatic practice session. To minimize tenant impact there will be no road closures and arriving or departing aircraft may be sequenced in and out by the Air Boss. If you know you will want to fly during this period, please contact John Chambers, (208) 890-8408, to help with planning. During the 5-7 PM period, call "Air Boss", with your request on 120.1 MHz.

Set-up Timetable

Friday morning setup begins at 8 AM. Approximately 9 AM a team will begin moving the remaining aircraft from the tie-down area to the temporary tie-down location. There will be a lot of support personnel moving about in lots of areas affecting the transformation to the air show configuration. If you are not involved in the air show setup, please avoid the area between gates 2 and 5 to reduce the congestion level.



A-10 Security

The A-10s will be on the airport a day or two ahead of the air show. A military unit will be providing security. The Air force is serious about protecting their plans on the ground; please do not attempt to approach the A-10's.

Airspace Schedule:

Thursday rehearsal: Waiver in effect from 5-7 PM

Friday Sponsor Show: Waiver & TFR from 5:30-9:30 PM

Saturday Show: Waiver from 10 AM/ TFR from 11 AM
— both ending at 6 PM

The **TFR** (Temporary Flight Restriction, a special type of NOTAM) area includes a 3-mile radius circle centered on our airport and extends from the surface up to 12,000 ft MSL. No non-participating flight is permitted within an active TFR area. Flight is permitted with an air show PPR AND while in contact with the Air Boss.

The "**waiver**" sets aside some of the usual flight rules to permit, in part, low, fast and aerobatic flight at the airport for the air show. A part of the waiver also involves observing specific safety areas and creating certain "sterile" zones during that time.

Idaho Mission: Aerospace

This year the Ryan J Poe Foundation, in conjunction with the air show, will sponsor something brand new. A veritable Who's Who of aviation's finest will be on hand June 24th to deliver an exciting presentation to local young people. Astronaut and Idaho Educator Barbara Morgan will headline a distinguished panel of space and aviation heroes in this, the first Idaho Mission: Aerospace event. Morgan will be joined by A-10 West demonstration pilot Joe "Rifle" Shetterly, Idaho air show pilot Greg Poe, Micron CEO and pilot Steve Appleton, and members of the Idaho Division of Aeronautics.

The event is being held at 9 AM at the Greg Poe Aviation Hangar, 518 Dishman Pl. For more information call (208) 455-0700 or visit www.ryanjpoe.org.

Airport Manager's Office

The office will be closed much of Thursday afternoon, the 23rd and all day Friday and Saturday June 24th and 25th due to air show support activities. No tenant ticket vouchers or parking permits will be available when the office is closed.



Airport Café

Carol and her crew will be open for business during the air show on Saturday and will be accessible through the walking gate from the Aviation Way parking lot side. She may extend her hours on Thursday and/or Friday, depending on customer demand.

Can I Fly That Weekend?

Yes and no. The air show NO-TAM will close the airport to regular activity and indicate that a PPR number is needed to arrive/depart from 8 AM Friday through 6 PM Saturday. Aircraft can arrive or depart on Friday up to as late as 5 PM (with a PPR), if they want to access a hangar that's outside the "snow fence" **and** is not obstructed by other air show setup activities. Fuel may or may not be available depending on what you need and what setup activities are going on at that time. All aircraft movement on Friday and Saturday must be coordinated with the Air Boss. **PPR numbers will be issued by DuWaine at (208) 850-9987.** Saturday departures must be completed before 8 AM. The airfield should be available for returning aircraft Saturday after 6 PM.

Please keep in mind that returning aircraft will need to exercise extra caution as air show tear-down will be in full swing at that time. If you plan to use your aircraft on Friday or Saturday, be sure that it's parked someplace outside the snow fence or, preferably, relocated to another airfield.
