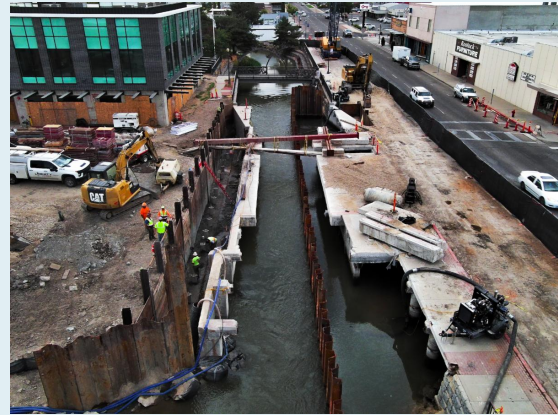


Kimball Bridge Update

Construction is moving forward on the Kimball Bridge. Here is what to expect this week and next:

This week, crews will:

- Finish removing the old bridge and walls on the south side.
- Continue forming the north bridge abutment and tying rebar.



Next week:

- Blaine Street will be reduced to one lane from Tuesday, Sept. 8 through Friday, Sept. 11.
- The lane restriction will be in place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day.
- This will allow crews to place a concrete barrier and work along the south side of the bridge.

The Kimball Bridge Project is expected to wrap up in late 2026.

Kimball Mini Plaza and Alleyway Update

Crews formed and placed concrete in the the alleyway between 9th Street and the park.

What to expect this week:

- Crews will demo the existing alleyway behind Grit 2C and Chop Shop on Wednesday, Sept. 2.

Once the demo is complete, the alleyway will still be accessible until mid-September.
