Kimball Bridge Update

Current traffic impacts:

- Blaine Street restricted to one lane between 9th and 7th avenues each day from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Friday, Sept. 11.

This week, crews will be:

- Placing concrete barrier along the south side of the bridge. This will allow them to demo the south side of the bridge and excavate the area.
- Forming the abutment on the north side of the bridge and placing rebar.



The Kimball Bridge Project is expected to wrap up in late 2026.

Kimball Mini Plaza and Alleyway Update

This week, crews will be:

- Finishing placing pavers between 9th Street and the park.
- Pouring concrete on the second half of the alleyway between the park and Kimball later this week.

Once the section between 9th and Kimball is complete, crews will move to the Kimball Plaza area behind Grit 2C and Chop Shop.



The Kimball Plaza and alleyway project is expected to wrap up in November.

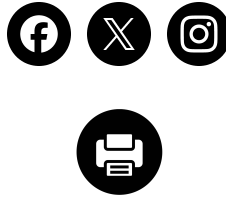
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
