

INDIAN CREEK BRIDGE ON USTICK ROAD

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE!



Over the last two weeks, crews have:

- Placed concrete for the floor and box culvert (bridge) of the Ustick Bridge over Indian Creek.
- Completed the new railroad tracks.

Over the next couple of weeks, crews will be:

- Placing concrete to finish up the Ustick Bridge.
- Installing water and sewer lines.
- Placing curbs and sidewalks along Ustick Road.

Ustick Road is expected to reopen with one lane in each direction this fall. The project is anticipated to be complete by early 2026.



What to expect during construction:

- Work is happening during the day from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- Ustick Road will remain closed through the fall.
- Crow Drive is closed.
- Drivers will detour using Cleveland Boulevard, Linden Street and Middleton Road.

Reminder, please do not walk, bike, or drive through the construction zone!

The area is closed for your safety as crews begin removing and replacing the bridge over Indian Creek. Entering the work zone is dangerous and puts both you and the workers at risk.

The City of Caldwell is replacing the Indian Creek Bridge on Ustick Road, improving the railroad crossing and widening the road to match improvements completed in 2023.

Construction began in early July and is expected to be complete by early 2026.
