

CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

Construction begins fall 2025 to replace the Kimball Bridge over Indian Creek in Caldwell. The bridge has reached the end of its design life and is in need of replacement. Work is expected to be completed in summer 2026.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Kimball Avenue will be closed between Blaine Street and Arthur Street.
- Motorists and pedestrians will be detoured.
 - Lane and parking closures will occur on Blaine Street.
 - Business access will remain open, but your route may change.
 - Street parking will be restricted in the project area.

The safety of the public and crews is the City of Caldwell's top priority during construction. What's happening in the work zone is interesting and it can be tempting to see what the team is up to. Please do not enter the work zone at any time. To remain informed about what is happening in the project area, sign up for construction updates using the information below.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why is this project necessary?

The Kimball Bridge over Indian Creek is aging and must be replaced. This bridge includes two structures—the first was built in the 1930s and the second was built in the 1970s. The new bridge is expected to serve the City of Caldwell for many years to come.

Will this project make any changes to the intersection of Kimball Avenue and Blaine Street?

This project will not change the traffic pattern at the intersection of Kimball Avenue and Blaine Street. The project will install detectable warning surfaces at the Kimball Avenue crosswalk on the north side of Blaine Street.

How will parking be impacted near the project area?

On-street parking will not be available on Kimball Avenue between Blaine Street and Arthur Street. Parking will also be restricted in the project area on the right side of Blaine Street. Crews do not anticipate impacts to parking outside of these areas.

How can I access businesses near the project area?

Business access will remain open during construction, although your route may change. View the detour map on the other side of this fact sheet to plan your route in advance.
