- Log in or create an account in Citizenserve (Citizenserve Users Guide)
- Select your permit and/or application type and enter in all required information.

Step 2

Pay fees online via Citizenserve. You will receive an email from Citizenserve directing you to make a
payment once staff have reviewed your application.

Drawing Submittal Instructions:

- 1. All plan sheets must be uploaded in PDF format only (no CAD, JPEG, TIFF, PNG, etc.)
- 2. All plan sheets must be to scale.
- 3. All plan sheets must be uploaded to Citizenserve.
- 4. All applications, checklists, calculations, reports, drawings, plans, and other supporting documents must be uploaded as single-sided pdf's and must be legible and in a high-definition format.
- 5. All documents and plans must follow the "Naming Schematic" as listed on the attached document.



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Annexation (with initial zoning)

CCC Chapter 10, Article 3, Section 10-03-01

<u>PURPOSE</u>: Annexation is a legal process by which some property located in an unincorporated area (Canyon County) may become part of the incorporated area (City of Caldwell). Annexations may be initiated by the City with property in the City Impact Area or by individuals with property in the City Planning Boundaries. An annexation requested by an individual is a quasi-judicial matter requiring public hearings and public hearing notification in accordance with the Idaho Land Use Planning Act and Caldwell City Code.

The following items shall be included in the application submittal. Additional information may be required upon official review of the plans. Please check the box for each item listed below to confirm submission of the item listed.

I. Filing and Submittal Standards

All applications, checklists, plans and supporting documents must be submitted electronically through
our Online Permit Center.
Upload all documents and drawings per required checklist, as high-resolution PDFs and formatted in
accordance with this checklist.
Each checklist item MUST be named according to the naming convention listed below. The naming
convention shall start with the document name as shown in the table below, followed by an
underscore, and then the project name.
Resubmittals must use the EXACT same file name as the original and contain a versioning number at
the end (V2, V3, V4, etc.)
All applicable fees be required to be paid once the application has been submitted and received by the
department. Some applications may require fees to be paid at time of actual submittal.

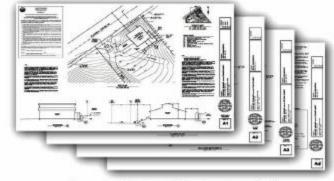

Format: Vector-based files are preferred given the ability to scale these files.

Resolution: Min. of 300 pixels per inch (PPI)

On behalf of SI Construction LLC (the "Applicant"), please find enclosed application materials related to the proposed annexation, zoning, and preliminary plat (the "Application") of a 4.6-acre parcel located off Dorman Ave and proceeding through the property through to Manchester Drive (Parcel number R2799800000) (the "Property").



1. Property Background and Site Characteristics

This is real property located within the area of impact of the City of Caldwell (the "City") and is designated by the City's future land use map as **Neighborhood 2**.

Neighborhood 2 is the primary residential place type in Caldwell. This encompasses residential areas that provide an array of low and mid-density housing options. These neighborhoods are located outside of most commercial centers but should still be well connected to nearby services.

Density Minimum: 2 du/ac

Density Maximum: 8 du/ac

Comprehensive Plan, p. 24

The Property currently consists of an existing single-family residence that will remain on the Property.



Surrounding characteristics of the site are as follows:

North – Single Family Residential.

East – Single Family Residential

South - Single Family Residential

West – Single Family Residential / Farm ground

2. The Application

The Application calls for a R-2 zoning designation to allow for 38 lots – consisting of one detached single-family lots (the existing home), 31 attached single-level single family buildable residential units, and 6 common area lots. The proposed residential lots will be for sale lots.

In the pre-application meeting, Caldwell city planning staff recommended that the Property, if annexed and rezoned, be zoned as R-2 (Community Residential), with a maximum density of 8 units per acre. The Applicant is seeking approval for an R-2 zoning designation, with a density of 6.9 units per acre.

R-2 ZONE: The purpose of this zone is to provide areas by zoning procedures in accordance with the comprehensive plan that accommodates a larger variety of lot sizes and housing types. This includes single-family residential (including accessory dwelling units) and missing middle housing types such as townhomes, duplexes, triplexes, fourplexes, cottage courts, small scale multi-family, or mansion house apartments. Supporting or secondary land uses may include small-scale mixed-use or live/work housing types, and commercial activities and services that are generally only found at major intersections of arterial and collector roadways.

An important component of the Application is the proposed restriction of residence ownership to owners 55 and over. This provides the community will much needed residential opportunities to older community residents nearby to existing services (such as neighborhood parks, gathering areas, or shopping opportunities). The low-maintenance lifestyle and amenities will attract empty-nesters looking

to downsize and enjoy a more relaxed retirement in Caldwell and what the City has to offer. The age restrictions contribute to a quieter atmosphere, making it a desirable option for those seeking a tranquil and relaxing environment, providing another available housing product for Caldwell as the City accommodates the needs of its current and future residents.

3. Comprehensive Plan

The goals of the Caldwell Comprehensive Plan will be put into effect with this application. This is infill development, bringing into the City an enclave of County property with services immediately available, thereby fulfilling the Annexation Policy, specifically page 98, and meeting the need for additional housing:

Caldwell has fewer housing units than households and is growing faster than new housing units are added.

Comp. Plan, p. 8

Chapter 6 – Goal 3.2 Promote infill housing developments to maximize existing infrastructure and slow the loss of open space.

The Application also address the Neighborhood 2 recommended Design Characteristic in the Comprehensive Plan and the single level townhomes are consistent with the adjacent 1-2 story residences and will blend with the existing homes seamlessly.

Neighborhood 2 contains a diverse mix of uses. Where uses or intensity of uses change, efforts to blend building scales should be made to avoid abrupt changes in height and building size.

Comp. Plan p. 24-25

The proposed project also meets the goal of connecting existing streets in the City, as the Project will connect Manchester Drive to Dorman.

Chapter 3 – Goal 1.4 Connect residential development with existing streets and require future connection to the City's planned system.

The proposed project will connect the existing residential development to the east, providing increased traffic connectivity. Based on the road layout, the curve in the proposed extension of Manchester Drive will encourage slow moving traffic through the neighborhood. Based on the size of the proposed development, a traffic study is not required or warranted.

4. Services

Dorman Townhomes Subdivision is adequately served with <u>all</u> public services and utilities. A summary of each service is available below.

• **Sewer**: The Project will be served by City of Caldwell Sewer via the <u>existing</u> 8-inch sewer stub on Manchester Drive. The Developer has confirmed with the City that <u>adequate</u> capacity exists to serve the Project.

- Domestic Water: Water service is available from the City of Caldwell via existing water mains on both Manchester Drive (8 inch main) or on Dorman Ave. (12 inch main) to the property. The Developer discussed the water services with City staff during the roundtable discussion and the City has adequate capacity to serve the Project.
- **Irrigation**: Gravity irrigation is provided by Pioneer Irrigation District via the Phyllis Canal. A pump station will be constructed onsite for pressure irrigation service with the review and appropriate permitting/license agreement process. Potable water will not be used for irrigation.
- Schools: The Project is in the Caldwell School District. Because the proposed development will be
 restricted to residents 55 years and older, it is anticipated there will be no impact on the capacity
 of the Caldwell School District. For informational purposes, Woodrow Wilson Elementary School,
 Jefferson Middle School, and Caldwell Senior High School would be served by the residents of the
 Project.
- **Fire**: The project is approximately 2.2 miles from Fire Station #2 and wholly within the Caldwell Fire response time goal of 5 minutes.
- **Police**: The project is approximately 2.9 miles from Caldwell Police Department Headquarters and will have a response time to an emergency within 5 minutes or less.
- Stormwater: Stormwater drainage will be on site and will handled via seepage beds.

5. Open Space

The Applicant is retaining 10% of the project in qualified open space. As you can see from the attached rendering, a community common space will be provided, suitable for a shade structure and picnic tables, as well as grassy open space areas around the required drainage spaces.

The subdivision will be accessed from Dorman Street and will proceed through the property through Manchester Drive. The newly constructed road will be a local street and will be designed and constructed to the City of Caldwell's standards. The common area lots at the entrances to the subdivision will be landscaped and will frame the development and be welcoming and visually appealing. The existing farmhouse will be retained and will provide a transition to the single-story residences to be developed.

6. Conclusion

We appreciate your review of these materials and look forward to further dialogue as these Applications approach hearing.
