To our downtown businesses:

The City of Caldwell knows that these are trying times for our downtown businesses, and we are committed to providing whatever assistance we can in the coming weeks to make sure you are able to continue to succeed and thrive. In that spirit, we would like to work with you to find ways that the right-of-way in our downtown may be used creatively to help your businesses continue to operate as robustly as the present circumstances permit.

During the term of the state Order to Self-Isolate, it may be the case that your businesses would be benefited by some particular, temporary use of adjacent right-of-way. It may be beneficial to have certain parking spaces reserved for carry-out orders only. It may be beneficial to have certain parking spaces reserved for loading and unloading delivery vehicles as your business temporarily shifts more heavily to off-site services. It may be beneficial to have special signage near the curb to identify carry-out policies or modified store hours. There are, no doubt, additional accommodations that would be helpful as well.

If there is a particular, temporary accommodation that might be beneficial to your business, we ask that you send a request to Debbie Geyer, our City Clerk, at dgeyer@cityofcaldwell.org stating what the requested accommodation would be, as well as the way in which it would benefit your business. Because we cannot foresee what the volume or specific scope of these requests may be, we cannot guarantee that any particular request will be granted. However, we will attempt to respond in a timely manner and provide approval, or some suggested alternative, whenever possible.

We hope that this temporary opportunity to creatively utilize the right-of-way will provide you with some tangible benefit, and as other aid comes available at the city, state, or federal levels, we will continue to pass along whatever information we can.
