**Trowbridge C. Egleston: 1895**

Mayor Elgeston was a wholesale and retail dealer in hardware, stoves, tinware, groceries, provisions, wagons and farm machinery. He was educated at Cornell University, Ithaca, New York and learned the hardware business in Albion. He worked at Prattt & Company in Buffalo for quite some time. He then became a traveling salesman for the Cambia Iron Company of Johnstown, Pennsylvania and later traveled for the Simmons Hardware Company of St. Louis. His travels and education lead him to Caldwell, where he purchased a hardware store. He controlled a trade that was quite extensive in the area. Mr. Egleston married Sarah B. Mann in 1878 and they had two daughters, Florence and Ethel.
