

**PUBLIC NOTICE** In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2) of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Planning and Development Programs and applicable waivers made available to those requirements through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, City of Caldwell is making an amendment to the Program Year 2019 Annual Action Plan available to the public through this notice. This Amendment is available for a minimum 5-day public review and comment period from June 5, 2020, to June 12, 2020.

This amendment will enable City of Caldwell to receive and administer a special allocation from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19. This allocation was authorized by the CARES Act, Public Law 116-136, and it includes \$292,484 under Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV) funding.

Activities funded by CDBG must contribute to the goals and objectives of City of Caldwell's Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan and meet all applicable federal requirements.

Additional funding made available to City of Caldwell by HUD through the CARES Act is unknown at this time but will be used for the same purpose of the initial allocations indicated above, which is to prevent the spread of coronavirus 19 (COVID-19) and facilitate assistance to eligible communities, households, and persons economically impacted by COVID-19.

A summary of the proposed activities to be funded with the additional funds is provided below:

CDBG-CV (\$292,484)

Public Services Activities \$ 260,000

Program Administration \$ 32,484

As part of this amendment, City of Caldwell has revised the Consolidated Plan's Citizen Participation Plan to include the 5-day comment period as indicated above, as well as to make other changes.
