



## PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with 24 CFR 91.105(c)(2) of the federal regulations relative to citizen participation for Community Planning and Development Programs and applicable waivers made available to those requirements through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

The City of Caldwell is an entitlement community through US Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The City of Caldwell has been allocated a total of \$497,196 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for city fiscal year 2021 and HUD program year 2020

The City of Caldwell will be carrying unspent funding from previous years to add into projected costs for a large bike/ped pathway project on Arthur Street. This project required the city to budget funds over multiple years.

A small amount of previous years unspent funds may be reallocated according to HUD GDBG requirements.

Activities funded by CDBG must contribute to the goals and objectives of City of Caldwell's Consolidated Plan/Annual Action Plan and meet all applicable federal requirements.

A summary of the proposed activities to be funded with current and projected resources is provided below:

Public Service Activities \$ 70,000

Funding is proposed for temporary rent/utility assistance and food security support for the City of Caldwell's most vulnerable residents.

Housing Activities \$140,000

Support development of new affordable multi-family and/or homeownership model single family homes in Caldwell. May also provide homebuyer assistance to eligible applicants.

Public Facilities and Infrastructure Improvements \$189,000

Support ADA restroom remodel at City Hall and balance of funds required for Arthur Street Multi-Model Bike Ped Pathway.

Monies will also be utilized for planning and administration activities. These activities include general program administration, subrecipient training/technical assistance, HUD required environmental reviews, activity monitoring and other eligible expenses.

To prepare HUD Program Year 2020 Annual Action Plan for submission, City of Caldwell has previously revised the Consolidated Plan's Citizen Participation Plan to include a shortened comment period.
